## MobileOffice for Android

MobileOffice is a business-grade voice and video softphone application featured on MiCall, the hosted IP telephony solution from Business Telecoms Direct. The app enables users to manage their communications easily and efficiently across PC and Mac desktops, smartphones and tablet devices including iPads.

The MobileOffice Android Edition allows you to make and receive calls over your MiCall service using a WiFi or 3G data connection through your Android device, bypassing traditional telephony networks.

The application can be used as a primary phone device or a secondary, additional device, using your MiCall telephone number.



### Highlights

- Business class calling features allow the Android device to become an extension of your office and provides key features such as extension dialling, call hold, transfer, conference, speakerphone, mute and voicemail
- MobileOffice uses built-in device functionality such as Dial-out from Contacts and Call History
- Using MobileOffice bypasses the mobile network by using Wi-Fi to make calls over an IP network, allowing free On-Net calls between your users and cheaper calls
- The application is simple and free to download directly from the Android Market app store and the chargeable license is easy to provision via the self-service MiCall portals (SPA and Admin Portal)
- Provisioning is securely and remotely controlled by the MiCall core - simply download the application and enter your username and password
- MobileOffice uses all MiCall codecs including G722 (HD Voice), G711 and G729
- MobileOffice works on MiCall+ user licenses and MiLine Premium user licenses.

### Additional information

If you wish to use MobileOffice on a secondary device then you will need Shared Call Appearance 10 at an additional cost. If MobileOffice is to be deployed on SIP Trunking then you will require Shared Call Appearance 5.

### Availability

The MobileOffice Android Edition license is available as a chargeable User Add-On and is billed monthly per user in line with published rates.

The application itself is available to download from the Android Market store.
